**Hours/Location:** 12 hours per week. Applicants must have flexible schedules and be available during normal business hours. Location is Tukwila, WA.

**Responsibilities:** This multi-faceted, part-time position is responsible for:

- Providing empowerment-based domestic violence advocacy with Latina survivors of abuse.
- Conducting domestic violence support groups for survivors of abuse.
- Attending Latina community events in representation of DAWN.
- Completing appropriate paperwork and documentation for the Latina advocacy program

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Fluent Spanish speaker and extensive knowledge of and experience with the Hispanic/Latino culture and community.
- Bachelor's degree in social work or related field. Relevant work experience can be substituted for the educational requirement.
- Must have a minimum of 20 hours of basic training covering theory and implementation of advocacy-based counseling and domestic violence issues.
- One year of recent experience providing advocacy services in the violence against women arena, with an emphasis on working with Latina survivors.
- Strong written and oral communication skills, listening skills, and a demonstrated ability to foster a supportive client environment.
- Ability to work in a confidential manner and in a confidential setting.
- A strong commitment to DAWN's mission and values.
- Experience with and ability to work as a team member and positive contributor to a workplace environment, and to work to ensure the success of others.
- Own transportation, a valid Washington State driver's license and proof of auto insurance.
- Current CPR/First Aid, or able to secure within one month of employment.
