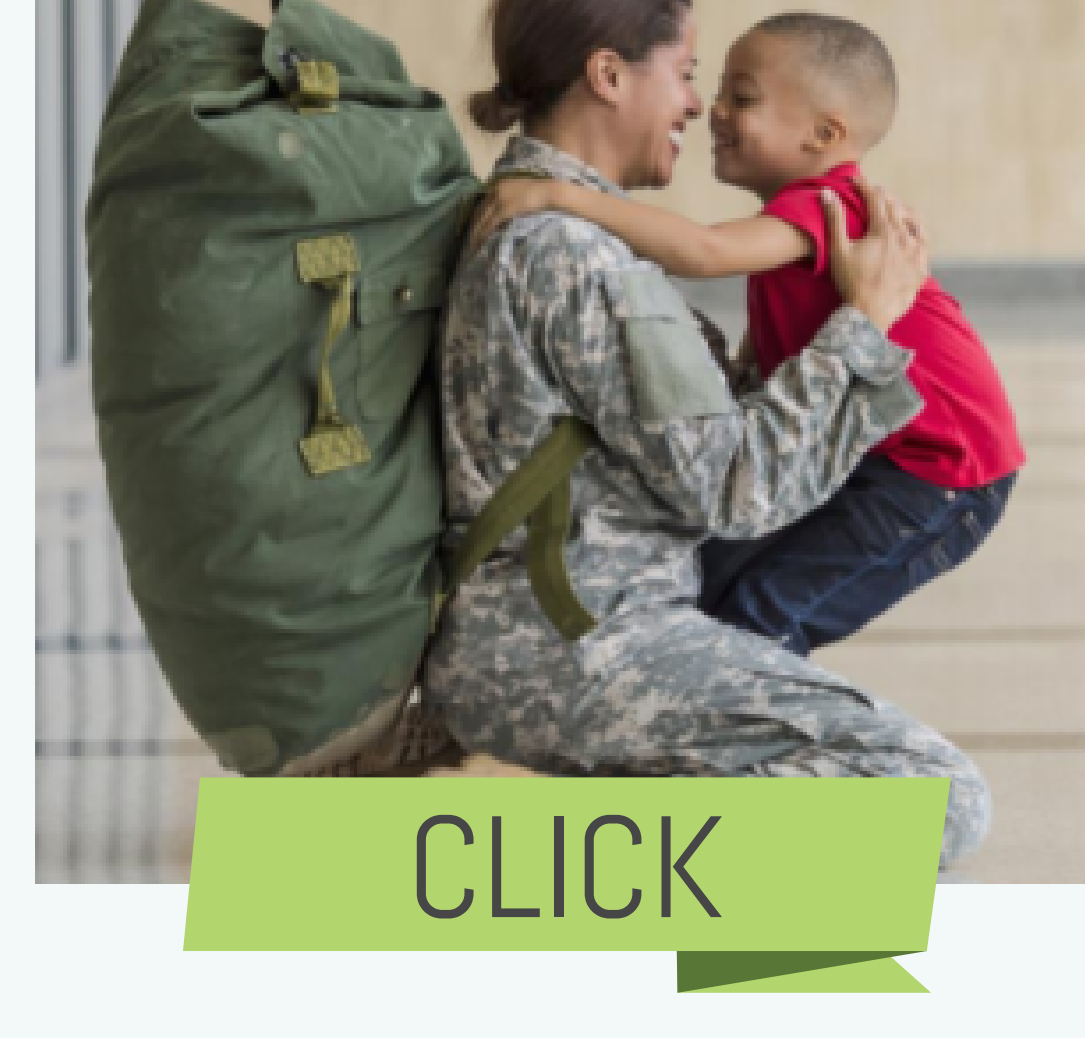

Join us as we share stories (and songs!) of successful housing advocacy and get revved up for a full week of action. Light refreshments will be provided.

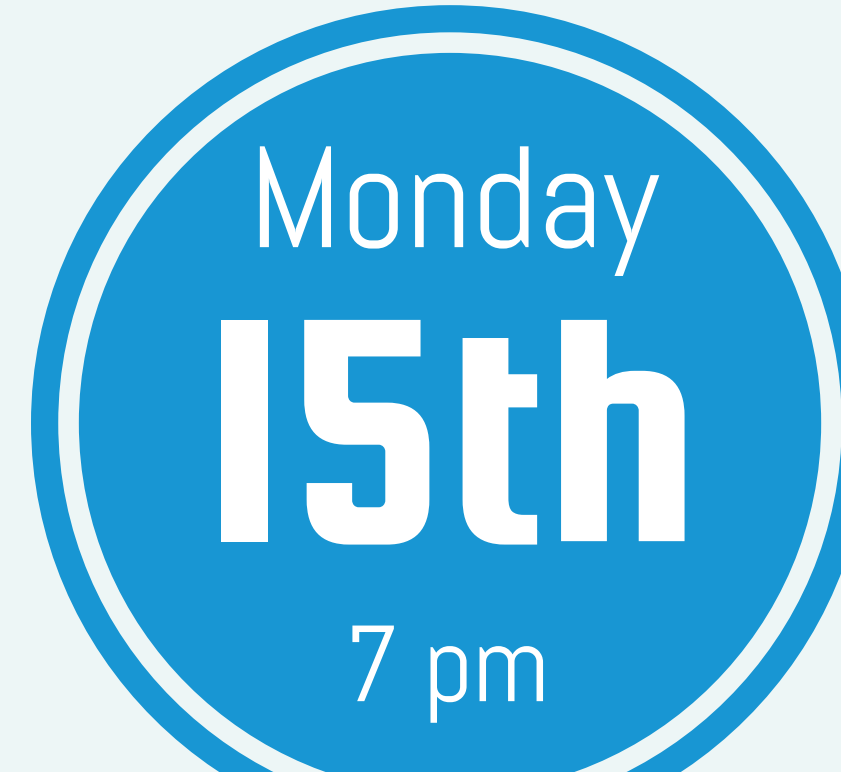
### Material Health & Energy in Affordable Housing
