Population Served: Low-income individuals and families, with 40 units set aside for families transitioning out of homelessness

Number and Type of Units: 133 units at 0-60% AMI

- 24 studios
- 37 open one-bedrooms
- 19 one-bedrooms
- 33 two-bedrooms
- 20 three-bedrooms

Building Description: Arbora Court, located in the University District, brings 133 affordable homes, including 53 two and three-bedroom apartments, to Seattle at a time when affordable housing is becoming extremely hard to find, especially for larger families. Forty of the apartments have been set aside for households transitioning out of homelessness. Arbora Court was made possible by a below-market land sale by University Christian Church to Bellwether Housing. The Seattle Housing Authority is providing rent subsidies for the 40 units that will house formerly homeless families. In addition to featuring larger sized apartments, Arbora Court offers other amenities including an outdoor play area, a roof-top deck, and a community kitchen and gathering room. The building is located near frequent bus service, the forthcoming U-District Light Rail Station, several grocery stores, a Seattle Public Library Branch, and community centers. Arbora Court exemplifies Bellwether's commitment to building affordable homes in locations that put opportunities, amenities, and services within easy reach of residents.
