POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The Development Manager is responsible for managing planning and development of affordable housing design for low-income individuals or families. This position also provides consultation and technical assistance to external clients.

- Provide vision for deal structure for affordable housing developments.
- Conduct feasibility analysis and due diligence on funding sources and site acquisition.
- Lead land acquisitions, including the preparation of purchase and sale agreements, option agreements, boundary line adjustments, lease agreements and required documentation for other land use approvals.
- Develop and maintain relationships with service partners, public funders, and regulatory entities.
- Develop and maintain capital and operating budgets for affordable housing developments.
- Understand, document, and communicate requirements of zoning, entitlements, and financing to the design team and asset management to ensure project success.
- Manage design process with architects including securing all land use and building permits.
- Create, maintain, and manage project schedules for developments.
