- WHEREAS, each \$100 increase in median rent results in a 15 percent increase in homelessness in metro areas and a 39 percent increase in homelessness in nearby suburbs and rural areas, and projections show that by 2044, King County will need nearly 200,000 net new housing units for households at or below 80 percent area median income; and
- **WHEREAS**, everyone benefits from affordable housing, including the people who reside in these properties, their neighbors, businesses, employers, underserved and at-risk populations, and the community as a whole; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Covington endorses Affordable Housing Week, and recommits to informing the public of the critical need to preserve and increase affordable housing in our community to ensure all people in it live with dignity in affordable homes;
